

**HIGH PLAINS UNDERGROUND WATER CONSERVATION DISTRICT NO. 1  
NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING**

Notice is hereby given that the Board of Directors of the High Plains Underground Water Conservation District No. 1 ("District") will hold a public hearing on Tuesday, February 21, 2012, at 10:00 a.m. in the District office located at 2930 Avenue Q, Lubbock, Texas, 79411, to discuss, consider, receive public comment, and potentially act on the adoption of a temporary moratorium on civil penalties for violations of certain District Rules related to groundwater pumping limits and the adoption of an Enforcement Policy and Civil Penalty Schedule ("Policy") governing enforcement and penalties for violations of the District Rules. The Policy will establish civil penalties that are substantially lower than the maximum amount authorized by state law. The Policy, as well as the moratorium which is included in the Policy, will be presented as amendments to the District Rules and will constitute rules of the District for all purposes once adopted.

All interested members of the public are invited to attend. Any person who wishes to present comments or other information at the hearing may do so in person, by counsel, or both. Comments may be presented verbally or in written form. Limits may be placed on the amount of time that each person is allowed to present verbal comments at the hearing. The hearing posted in this notice may be recessed from day to day or continued where appropriate. Any person with a disability who needs special accommodations should call 806-762-0181.
